


## Start from the port 1

A 3.65km route to explore the "Coron des 120" (mining housing estate) and Château Dampierre. You can make a stop on the Valmont Park fitness trail and complete a series of exercises. Return to the port by taking the T1 tram line at the "Anzin Hôtel de Ville" stop.

#### Start from the port 2

A 5km route through the "Cité of Mont de la Veine" (mining housing estate) and on the slopes of the spoil heap of Bleuse Borne which dominates the landscape.

There are 2 routes for exploring Anzin and its mining heritage which is a listed UNESCO World Heritage site.

#### Start from the tourist information office (rue Askièvre)

Explore the city centre of Valenciennes (6.2km) using the free app : Runnin' City. Follow the course "Valenciennes with small strides" in the category Smart Run.

## The Un'Escaut loop

Starting from the port, this 29km route links Valenciennes to the fortified town of Condé-sur-l'Escaut. Numerous former mining sites listed by UNESCO as World Heritage sites (mining towns, old Gueules Noires pit railway, subsidence ponds, the spoil heap of the Chabaud-Latour site, etc) line the route.

## Valenciennes, city of artists

## The Rhônelle Valley

This hike offers the opportunity to discover the enchanting countryside of Valenciennes (Aulnoy-lez-Valenciennes, Artres, Famars, Préseau). Start from the "Jules Chevalier" stop of the T1 tram line and take the foot path along the tracks.
